A motion was made by Gust Hatanelas and seconded by Seth Rauch to remove Cattle Guard at Landfill off the table for discussion. Motion passed. A discussion ensued among board members; Gary Waldner stated he would be able to do the installation of the cattleguard at the landfill as he did have help now. The installation will be done on a weekend so they will not be interrupting our daily activities for the Landfill. Gary's company WTC was awarded the bid previously.

New Business:

A motion was made by Gust Hatanelas to pay bills check #16610 thru check #16659 including all EFT's and all DC's in the amount of \$55,662.67. Gary Waldner seconded this motion. Motion passed.


Lowell Clawson abstained on check # 16648 to Plus Electric due to pecuniary interest.
