Minutes
Regular Meeting/ Conference Call
March 17, 2022

Chairman Lowell Clawson called this meeting to order at 5:04 p.m.
Board members present at the Bairoil Office were Dean Martin and Clerk-Manager Sue Rigano.
Board Members present via telephone were Vice Chairman Gary Waldner, Seth Rauch.
Also Via telephone were Landfill Supervisor Jeff Evans and Landfill Operator Ben Carter.
Hal Good was absent.

There was NO public comment.

With no changes necessary the minutes of February 17, 2022 stand as written.

A motion was made by Seth Rauch and seconded by Gary Waldner to accept the Agenda for March 17, 2022 as presented. Motion passed.

Reports:

A discussion ensued as to having a town cleanup day for Wamsutter and Bairoil. It needs to be a Saturday; we are looking at late May or June. No date has been set at this time; we will check with the Town's to see what works best for them.

New pickup: We ordered (2) new pickup trucks July 2021, we still have not received them.
Chairman Clawson stated he spoke with the salesman this week and (1) truck is in Denver waiting to be transported to Riverton, the other truck is still in Canada.

Re-Calculations of Closure/Post Closure for DEQ:

Clerk Manager Sue Rigano stated the paperwork she sent to Engineer Tom Pilch was (from the Bank of Commerce showing the notice of maturity date and interest to be paid on each CD, marked Post Closure). When Sue received an e-mail from Mike Jennings asking for a printed-out report of Post Closure Cd's, Sue printed off a Post/closure report from our QuickBooks. There was a difference of \$13.67 between the (2) reports making our total bill \$473.46. Chairman Clawson signed off on the original report on February 17, 2022, for \$459.79.

This report was re calculated and Chairman Lowell Clawson signed off on this March 3, 2022, for \$473.46.

Quarantine Time for Covid 19 Lowered.

Chairman Clawson stated his understanding now, if you test positive for Covid-19 and have **NO symptoms you stay out **5** days, if you still have no symptoms, you can come back to work. If you do have symptoms you have to stay out **10** days, then with no symptoms you may return to work. The Solid Waste District #2 have been having our employees stay off work **14** days, Chairman Clawson feels we should re-consider our policy. **

NEW: If you test positive for COVID-19 and have **NO** symptoms, you stay out (5) days. If you still have no symptoms, you can come back to work on the 6th day with a negative test. If you test **positive** with symptoms, you must stay out (10) days. You can come back to work on the 11th day with a **negative** test. If on the (10th) day you still test positive you need to stay out another (4) days, you may return to work after a negative test.

You do need a **witness** that you took the test, and **Solid Waste does** need a copy of the negative test. **Employees will now have to use sick time or vacation time to get paid for being off with COVID-19.** Just a FYI- (This was not added to our employee handbook, but we did put it in our minutes.)

Old Dumpsters:

Landfill Supervisor Jeff Evans gave an update on getting rid of the old dumpsters at the Landfill. Mr. Evans stated he did speak with Pacific Steel they will take all the old dumpsters we want to get rid of, they did ask if the employees could stack them inside of each other to make it more efficient for them to haul. Mr. Evans stated that would not be a problem for the Solid Waste employees to do. The lids will have to be removed and then stack them 4 or 5 high, Mr. Evans said Pacific Steel would pay us \$50.00 a ton. Mr. Evans stated it is not necessarily about making a lot of money but just to get rid of them to make room in our storage area. Chairman Clawson stated he was happy with that arrangement. A motion was made by Gary Waldner and seconded by Seth Rauch to accept the amount of \$50.00 per ton from Pacific Steel for the old dumpsters to be hauled away. Motion passed.

Quote on Diesel Tanks at Landfill:

We received (3) bids, Chairman Clawson stated he would read each bid but after a discussion he would like to table this until the next meeting as he feels we need more information.

Bid #1: Wamsutter Conoco

Clear Diesel #1 and Clear Diesel #2: bid price will be the pump price discounted by .10 cents per gallon. My current pump price for clear diesel #1 is \$5.999 a gal. (discounted price would be \$5.899 per gallon). Current pump price for clear diesel #2 is \$5.299 (discounted price would be \$5.199 per gallon).

Red Dyed Diesel: Bid price will be pump price discounted by .10 cents per gallon.

Current pump price for Dyed #2 Diesel is \$4.899 per gallon (discounted price would be \$4.799 per gallon)

Dyed #1 Diesel is \$5.599 per gallon (discounted price \$5.499 per gallon).

**Delivery fee for south of Wamsutter with a tank wagon is \$165.00 per hour, which should take an hour to deliver to tank farm. **

We can supply 500-gal farm tank with stand, hose and nozzle for gravity fill with containment tank, or 838-gal tank with containment tank and 110 volt pump and meter.

Our fuel price for bulk and pump would be the same for Solid Waste. Our bulk diesel fuel comes from the bulk plant behind the Wamsutter Conoco Station, we have Clear Diesel #1 & #2 and Red Diesel #1 & #2 but NO bulk gasoline. We can supply bulk gasoline we just have to pump it from our pumps out front.

10 cents off per gallon would apply to bulk fuel delivered to the landfill and fuel gas and diesel you get at the pump with your Wamsutter Conoco fuel card.

This bid is good for March 17, 2022 through March 17, 2023, Signed by Gregg Waldner-Wamsutter Conoco.

A discussion ensued as to how far away the tanks would be located from power or if gravity fed tanks would work. Also, the height of the tallest piece of equipment whether gravity fed would work. The tallest piece of equipment is the Dozer, it is 9 feet, fuel tank is up by the cab, so gravity fed may be a problem.

These prices will be good for 3 months from this date, although Freight cost may change.


A motion was made by Seth Rauch and seconded by Dean Martin to table a decision until our meeting in April getting more information. Motion passed.
