Reminder

Normal Scheduled Trash Pick-up Days are:

Mondays, Fridays,

Extra pick-up for businesses on Wednesdays.

Days may vary due to weather conditions.

Dumpsters are the sole property of Sweetwater County Solid Waste District #2.
Dumpsters are for the community, no one person is assigned a dumpster.

If your dumpster is **“BLOCKED”** by a vehicle or if a vehicle is parked too close to the dumpster your dumpster will **NOT** be emptied.

We DO NOT stop our run to ask you to move a vehicle!

My employees have a camera; photos are taken and printed out with the date and time on the photo.

(These photos will **now** be mailed out to the violators)

Safety is our Priority!!

We have to have safe and easy access to all dumpsters.

No parking on either side of the dumpster.

Dumpsters next to doorways will be moved.

We are the only ones that can move the dumpsters.

DO NOT MOVE THEM! .

If you talk to us about dumpster location we can work with you on placement.

We will move dumpsters that do not meet our safety policies.

A dumpster that falls out of the back of the garbage truck will crush anything or anyone near it. (This does not happen often, but it **can** happen)

Continual moving of the dumpster will cause the dumpster to be pulled.

If your dumpster gets pulled you will have to contact Waste Management or Dirty Boyz to give you a dumpster and haul your trash, then you will be paying them for service.

Unbagged trash is a major issue!!!

Dumpsters that have unbagged trash will be skipped on any day the winds are 30+ mph.

When the winds are high the unbagged trash will blow everywhere.

It is not our responsibility to pick up trash that has blown out of the dumpster!.

We would appreciate your cooperation on these issues.
