Minutes

January 21, 2016

Held at the Carbon County Library, Carbon Room, Rawlins, WY 82301

Chairman Craig Davidson called this meeting to order at 6:00 pm.  
Other Board Members present were Secretary Lowell Clawson, Board member Dean Switzer.,  
Attorney David Erickson, Clerk-Manager Sue Rigano, and Clerk Kim Tompkins  
Bobbie Amos was absent due to illness.

Public Comment: Craig Davidson commended Jeff Evans for noticing an airbag suspension system was **not installed** on the new garbage truck.

With no changes to the minutes of December 17, 2015 they were signed and stand as written.

A motion was made by Lowell Clawson and seconded by Dean Switzer to accept the agenda for January 21, 2016 as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

Reports:

- (1) The new garbage truck has been delivered to Wamsutter. Upon delivery it was noticed that the airbag suspension had not been installed. It will be installed before we accept delivery of the vehicle. It was also noted there is a recall on the 2014 Cat GT. It will have to be out for about 2 weeks to be repaired.
- (2) There has been no interest in the temporary position at recycling. The employee will be going for surgery on the 28<sup>th</sup> of January and does not have a return date as of yet. It was stated by Dean Switzer that he possibly knew of a 17 year old that might be interested in the position. Attorney David Erickson stated "As long as no power equipment is involved it is legal to hire him should he be interested in the position."
- (3) The 2013 Expedition incurred a repair which was covered by the power train warranty.
- (4) We can change internet providers from Hughesnet to Union Wireless for the cost of \$1,080.85. This charge will be for both the Landfill and the Bairoil Office. A motion was made by Lowell Clawson to change to Union Wireless, and seconded by Dean Switzer. Motion passed.
- (5) Changes to rules for Municipal Solid Waste-DEQ were emailed to Tom Pilch. Tom emailed back and replied "he was not going to attend as it probably would not do any good anyway". He

then stated "the DEQ is in the process of cleaning up their rules and there is nothing that is going to affect the Sweetwater County Solid Waste District #2".

New Business:

(1) Board Elections

Lowell Clawson made a motion to nominate Dean Switzer to be the **new Chairman**.

Craig Davidson seconded. Motion **passed**. Lowell Clawson made a motion to nominate

Craig Davidson to be the **new Vice Chairman**, Dean Switzer seconded. Motion **passed**.

Craig Davidson made a motion to nominate Lowell Clawson for **Secretary/Treasurer**.

Dean Switzer seconded and the motion **passed**.

(a) Lowell Clawson made a motion to accept the application given by the Bank of Commerce, in Rawlins, WY as the depository, Dean Switzer seconded. Motion **passed**.

(b) A motion was made by Lowell Clawson to use the Rocket Miner from Rock Springs and the Rawlins Daily Times as our selected newspapers. Dean Switzer seconded this motion. Motion **passed**.

(2) Completed Audit for 2014-2015

Lowell Clawson made a motion to approve the completed audit. Dean Switzer seconded. Motion **passed**. There was no faults found in the documents sent to the auditors.


(3) Clerk-Manager Sue Rigano stated a request was made by the Landfill for a new tower (for the computer). Rodney Knight quoted a price of \$1,636.13. Lowell Clawson stated he would like to see if one could be purchased that would be better able to withstand dirt and dust and harsh environments for a much lower price. Sue Rigano will get back with Rodney Knight and see if these arrangement can be made. Lowell Clawson made a motion to **wait on a purchase until more information can be gathered**, Dean Switzer seconded the motion and motion **WAS NOT passed**.

(4) A motion was made by Lowell Clawson to pay Check numbers 13180-13232 including EFT/DC and excluding Check 13216. Dean Switzer seconded the motion. Motion **passed**.

Craig Davidson made a motion to pay check number 13216 to Plus Electric in the amount of \$957.87. Dean Switzer seconded. Motion **passed**. Lowell Clawson abstained due to pecuniary interest.
