The Scales at Landfill are not working again- Landfill Supervisor Jeff Evans stated he talked with Meldrum today, they were trying to walk Jeff through a possible issue fix, nothing worked. Meldrum will be out next week to repair the scales. Each time the scales break down it's a different issue.

New Business:

Engineer Tom Pilch has called for a meeting on September 18, 2025 to discuss the Closure of our Vertical Expansion pit, at Landfill at 10:30 a.m. All Board Members are invited to attend as well as Landfill Supervisor Jeff Evans and Clerk/Manager Sue Rigano.
