Minutes
August 14, 2025

Chairman Lowell Clawson called this meeting to order at 5:04 p.m.
Board Members present at the Bairoil office were Secretary-Treasurer Dean Martin, Butch McFall, and Clerk/Manager Sue Rigano.
Board Member attending Via-Conference call was Vice-Chairman Seth Rauch, Landfill Supervisor Jeff Evans and Landfill Operator Ben Carter.

Public Comment:

With no changes necessary, the minutes of July 17, 2025 stand as written.

A motion was made by Dean Martin and seconded by Butch McFall to approve the Amended Agenda of August 14, 2025 as presented.

Reports:

Clerk/Manager Sue Rigano stated everything requested by our auditors (PMCH) has been uploaded. They are still working to finalize the audit for 2024/2025.

Swapping packers on trash trucks.

Manager Sue Rigano stated she received an email from Richard with Peterbilt in Casper saying he was having a hard time putting together a quote from the pictures we sent to him. He asked if there was a day of the week both trucks could be in Bairoil then he could look them over.
Sue replied yes. Landfill Supervisor Jeff Evans asked Richard to pick a day that would work for him, then we would bring the other truck to Bairoil on whatever date Richard picks.
Richard has not responded as of this date.

Carbon County Weed and Pest came to our Landfill and the Bairoil transfer site on August 12, 2025. They sprayed around the buildings.

Landfill Supervisor Jeff Evans stated he requested Wyoming Machinery to come to the Landfill and check all our equipment before fall sets in.

Clerk/Manager Sue Rigano stated she received a call on 08-12-2025 from the local rancher Adams, he calls every year about litter that has blown outside our fenced landfill.
Supervisor Evans is taking care of this issue. We only have 2 summer employees this summer but we are working on the wind blown litter.

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Old Business:

Landfill Supervisor Jeff Evans informed Manager Sue Rigano that the Cat Mechanic working on our equipment told Jeff he was a certified CDL Trainer.

Manager Rigano contacted Chairman Clawson informing him of this. Chairman Clawson approved to switch CDL Trainers.

A discussion ensued among the board members. A motion was made by Dean Martin and seconded by Seth Rauch to ratify changing CDL trainers for the price of \$1200. Motion passed.

New Business:

Oilfield Cleanup Day:

Landfill Supervisor Jeff Evans informed Manager Rigano of the oilfield cleanup day 08-13-2025.

This was done by Williams/ R & P Oilfield and Crowheart.

No one called to inform anyone at the Landfill that this was happening.

Mr. Evans stated they brought in 20 pick-ups estimated 5000 lbs. of trash and 9 tires.

In the past we have waived the Landfill charge and did so again this year.

It is very important for us to be notified, as the tonnage of trash brought in must be weighed in and a charge ticket is necessary (just write -No Charge on the ticket)

The tonnage is reported to our Engineer so he can complete his report to the DEQ each year in September.

A motion was made by Dean Martin and Seconded by Butch McFall to wave the charge for the oilfield cleanup day. Motion passed.

A motion was made by Seth Rauch and seconded by Dean Martin to pay bills Check # 20127 through Check # 20180 including all EFT's and Dc's in the amount of \$118,241.32. Motion passed.
